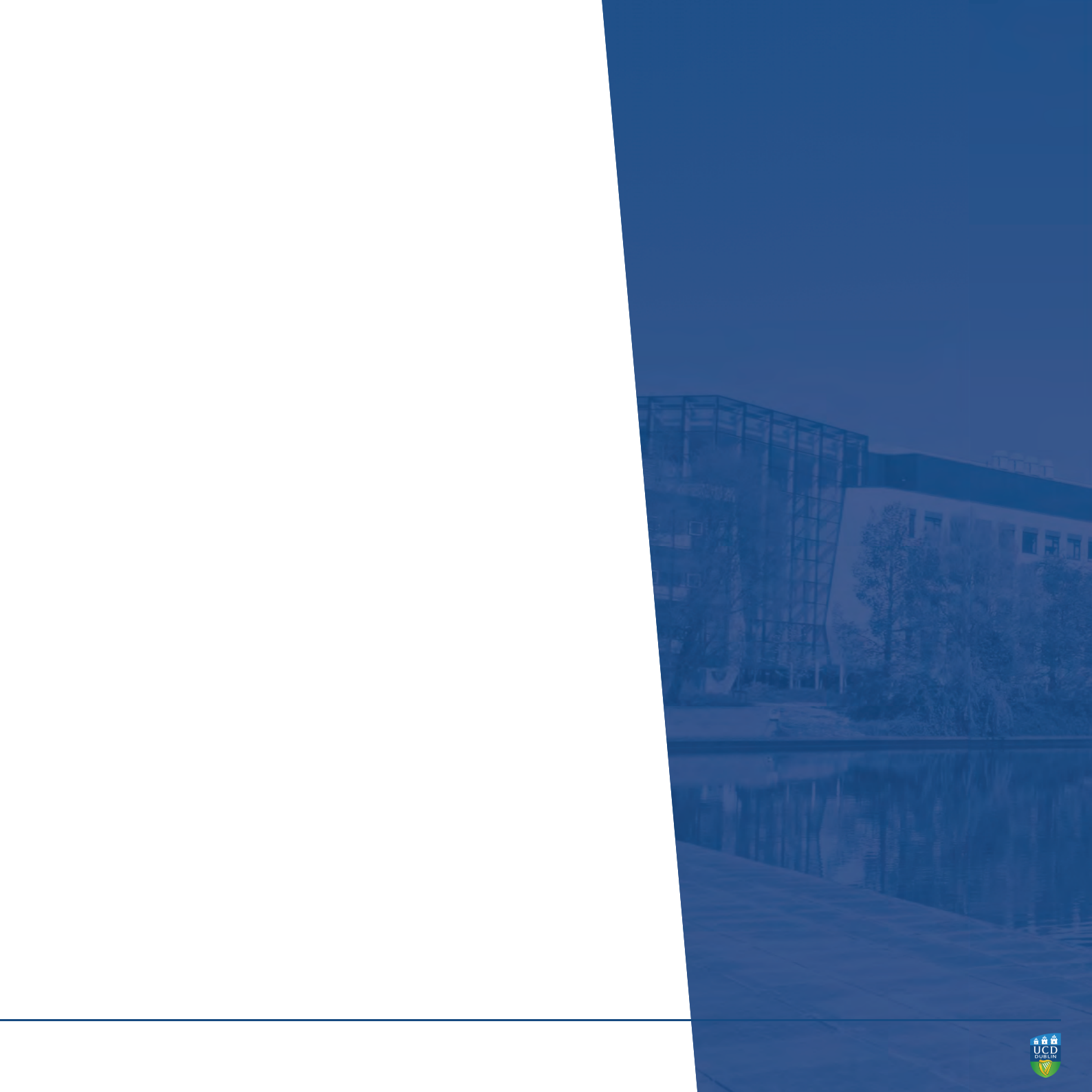

AT THE FOREFRONT OF GLOBAL KNOWLEDGE & RESEARCH STUDIES

Research and innovation are essential drivers of a dynamic economy, an informed society and a vibrant culture. The spectrum of research and innovation at UCD encompasses individual scholars, research groups, start-up companies and large-scale collaborations with industry and other partners. Research is conducted within each of the University's extensive range of disciplines and in multidisciplinary research programmes addressing challenges of global scale.

UCD has a broad research collaboration footprint. This is evidenced by collaborating on research publications with researchers based in 152 countries/regions. Almost 60% of UCD's research publications have international co-authors, while 5.7% of its publications have collaboration with industry.

From 2015 to 2020, UCD's researchers collaborated with colleagues from 5,569 institutions on 16,123 research publications within four priority research areas that address critical global research challenges. These are:

- Creating a Sustainable Global Society
- Transforming through Digital Technology
- Building a Healthy World
- Empowering Humanity

INSPIRING ACADEMICS

UCD is renowned for their exemplary lecturers and professors, whose approaches to teaching are as distinctive and varied as their subject matter. What unifies them all is the passion that they have for their field of expertise.

As an example featured are three of UCD's professors who were elected to the Royal Irish Academy in 2023 in recognition of their exceptional contributions to the sciences, humanities and social sciences, as well as to public service. Admittance to the Academy is the highest academic distinction in Ireland, and those elected by their peers are entitled to use the designation 'MRIA' after their name.

Professor Joanna Brück

A professor of Archaeology at UCD, an expert in the study of Bronze Age Britain and Ireland. Her research themes include the body and personhood, landscape, domestic architecture, material culture and deposition. Her more recent work has focused on 19th and 20th century Ireland, including the 1916 Rising and the archaeology of internment.

Professor Fengzhou Fang

A professor of Mechanical and Materials Engineering at UCD. Professor Fang specialist areas of interest include micro/nano manufacturing, optical freeform manufacturing, medical device/implants manufacturing, ultra-precision manufacturing and metrology. He has worked with over hundred industrial partners assisting companies to develop their R&D activities, and has published over 300 papers in peer reviewed journals and 50 patents.

Professor John Walsh

A professor of Earth Sciences at UCD. A founding Director of iCRAG, co-founder of the Fault Analysis Group and a member of the Sustainable GeoEnergy Research Group within the UCD School of Earth Sciences, Professor Walsh's research interests are wide-ranging, with a particular focus on the long- and short-term growth of fault systems and their impact on mineral deposits and geothermal and carbon capture systems.

The Academy has been honouring Ireland's leading contributors to the world of learning since its establishment in 1785. There are now 656 RIA members, including Nobel Laureates William C. Campbell and John O'Keefe; Louise Richardson, Vice-Chancellor of the University of Oxford; Philip Lane, European Central Bank; Fabiola Gianotti, Director General CERN; Brigid Laffan, Irish political scientist and Director of the Robert Schuman Centre for Advanced Studies; and Geraldine Byrne-Nason, Ireland's Permanent Representative to the UN.

As I wanted to work in regulatory management and approval of drugs, the MSc Biotechnology & Business course was crucial for my future success. We had the opportunity to work with a biotechnology start-up and create a business plan for a molecule, drug or medical device that they were working to bring to market. We presented to real investors to see if they would invest hypothetically had this been a real-world scenario. After graduation, I worked as a Clinical Research Coordinator in paediatric clinical trials across Children's Health Ireland at Crumlin and Temple Street Hospital. This role was part of a multidisciplinary team of researchers, consultants and investigators on both clinical trials and investigator led research studies in cystic fibrosis.

Fees are published in advance of the academic year, are fixed for each year and are subject to an annual increase. You must have sufficient funding in place before enrolling on your course. The cost of living varies from person to person but a large portion of your budget will be spent on accommodation. AWARDS EXPLAINED

National Framework of Qualifications (NFQ)

The NFQ is a ten-level system (1–10) giving an academic or vocational value to qualifications obtained in Ireland. UCD Graduate Courses have associated levels assigned to them in accordance with this framework.

UCD offer a modularised and credit-based curriculum:

Each module has a credit value typically ranging from 2.5 to 15 credits. This is calculated based on the total student effort. The total student effort includes time spent in-class (at lectures, seminars, laboratories, tutorials or workshops) and time spent on projects or assignments, as well as examinations. It also includes an estimate of independent study time.

One credit represents 20-25 hours of total student effort; therefore, a standard five credit module represents 100-125 hours of student effort.

GRADUATE TAUGHT PROGRAMMES

Graduate taught courses are usually taken by students who hold an undergraduate degree. The majority of the course will involve taking taught modules. In order to graduate with a master's degree, you will typically need to complete a dissertation.

UCD also offer Micro-credentials, which are a selection of accredited courses of 2.5 to 10 credits that provide learners with a globally recognised accreditation in specific subjects. In some cases, this credit can be stacked towards a UCD award, for example, a UCD Professional Diploma or Masters. GRADUATE RESEARCH PROGRAMMES

A research degree, i.e. a research master's degree, MD degree, PhD or professional doctorate, involves the sustained and in-depth study of a specific topic that is then written up as a thesis for examination. Research degrees involve students carrying out their own research and academic study under the guidance of their academic supervisor(s), supported by a Research Studies Panel.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Graduate Taught Programmes

The normal entry requirement is a recognised bachelor's degree at second class honours, grade one (2:1), or equivalent. Applicants should check the programme specific requirements as some degrees may require a higher standard for entry. For applicants who do not have the required minimum academic entry standard, a year long qualifying course, such as a Higher or Graduate Diploma, may be available in some cases.

Graduate Research Programmes

To be eligible to enter a research master's degree or PhD programme, an applicant must have obtained a minimum of a recognised bachelor's degree at second class honours, grade one (2:1) or equivalent in a relevant bachelor's degree. For a significant number of PhD programmes, a master's degree may also be required. Specific information on entry requirements can be found on the relevant UCD School website.

Recognition of Prior Learning

Credit may be awarded within a course for certificated or experiential prior learning achieved outside of that course. This is subject to Board approval. Please see Recognition of Prior Learning Policy Document (www.ucd.ie/governance/resources/policypage-rplpolicy/).

English Language Requirement

Graduate Taught and Graduate Research programmes in UCD are taught in English. Applicants must meet the minimum University English language proficiency requirements (www.ucd.ie/registry/prospectivestudents/admissions/policiesandgeneralregulations/generalrequirements/). In the case of IELTS Academic Version, a minimum score of 6.5 is required with not less than 6.0 in any strand. Please note, some courses may require a higher standard for entry. Please check the entry requirements of the course that you intend to apply for.

01 Choose your Programme

Using the course finder at www.ucd.ie/graduateadmissions, check the specific course entry requirements that can be found on the individual course listing pages.

02 Check the Closing Date

Most courses open for applications on 1st October and generally remain open for applications until all places are filled. As some courses have specific closing dates, check with the course co-ordinator.

03 Apply Online

Fill out the application form online at www.ucd.ie/graduateadmissions/applytoucd/. Note, applications for the Professional Master of Education and the Graduate Diploma in Public Health Nursing need to be made through the PAC website, www.pac.com.

04 Pay the Application Fee

An application fee is required for most application types (€50). This is payable during the application process using credit or debit card.

05 Prepare Supporting Documentation

When you submit your online application, you will receive a confirmation email and a list of required documents will be emailed to you. The documentation required varies depending on the course and may include academic references, a personal statement and transcripts. Use the upload facility, which is available once your application has been submitted.

HOW TO APPLY

GRADUATE RESEARCH PROGRAMMES

01 Contact Potential Supervisors

Identify one or two potential supervisors and contact them by email. All supervisors receive many potential applications by email and so an email out of the blue is completely normal. Always customise your email to the specific academic member of staff - you should review and reference their research profiles and recent publications. Include a statement of the type of research you are looking to undertake, what your previous studies have included and why you are approaching the specific individual. If you have a research question or research proposal already prepared, you can include this along with a CV if appropriate.

02 Funding your Research

Graduate research students at UCD are liable to pay fees, including the Student Centre Levy to the University. Students must budget for their own maintenance and accommodation. Prospective students are advised to carry out their own research and investigation regarding the availability of funding. Students are also advised to contact the relevant UCD School to ask about current funding possibilities.

03 Make an Application

Once you have the agreement of an academic member of staff to support your application, you will be asked by the School to either apply via the UCD online applications system (www.ucd.ie/graduateadmissions/applytoucd/) or directly to the School.

04 Pay the Application Fee

An application fee is required for most online applications (€50). This is payable during the application process using credit or debit card.

05 Prepare Supporting Documentation

Your school will advise you if further information or supporting documentation is required (e.g. academic references, a personal statement and transcripts).

06 Assessment of your Application

Your application will be reviewed by the School Graduate Admissions Committee on the basis of your academic qualifications, the alignment of the proposed research with the school's academic strategy, your personal statement and, where relevant, your English language proficiency. Only when you have been approved you can register to the research programme. For this reason, we recommend you apply at least two months prior to your expected start date.

WHAT HAPPENS AFTER I APPLY?

Application Review Process

Your application will be assessed on the basis of the information on your application form and the supporting documentation that you provide. Some Programmes/ Schools have specific application requirements and you may be required to attend for interview. It is important to include all required documents otherwise your application will be considered incomplete.

Application Status

You can check the progress of an online application by logging into your application account. You will receive an automated email alerting you of a change in the status of your application when a decision has been made.

Decision Process

UCD operates a rolling admissions policy for Graduate Taught Courses, with decisions being taken as soon as possible after receipt of completed applications. In general, courses will remain open until all places are filled. However, some programmes may have specific closing dates. Please consult the course coordinator for more details. For Graduate Research decisions, you will be contacted directly by the School (see page 34 for more information).

Accepting a Place

Ensure your place on the course by accepting your offer. If you are accepting online, you may be asked to submit an enrolment deposit, normally €500. This deposit is applied towards your tuition fees.

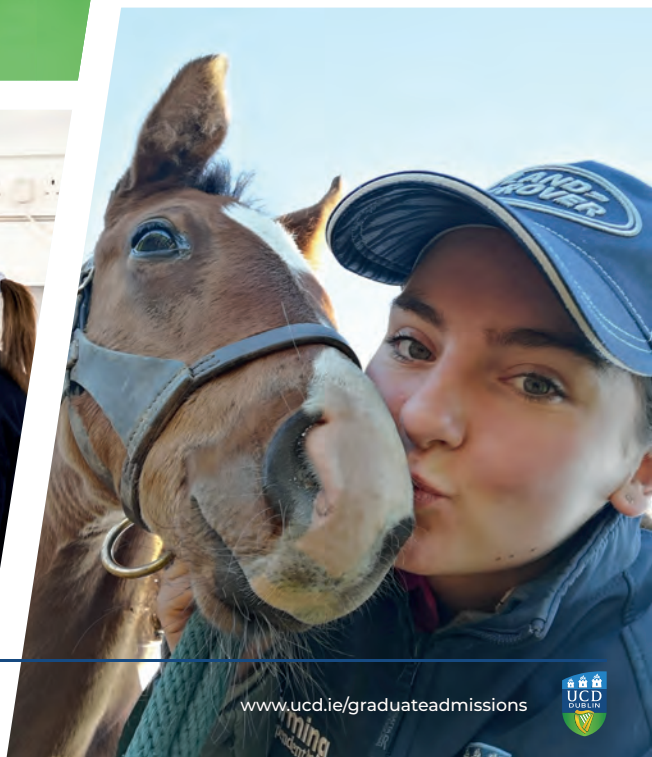

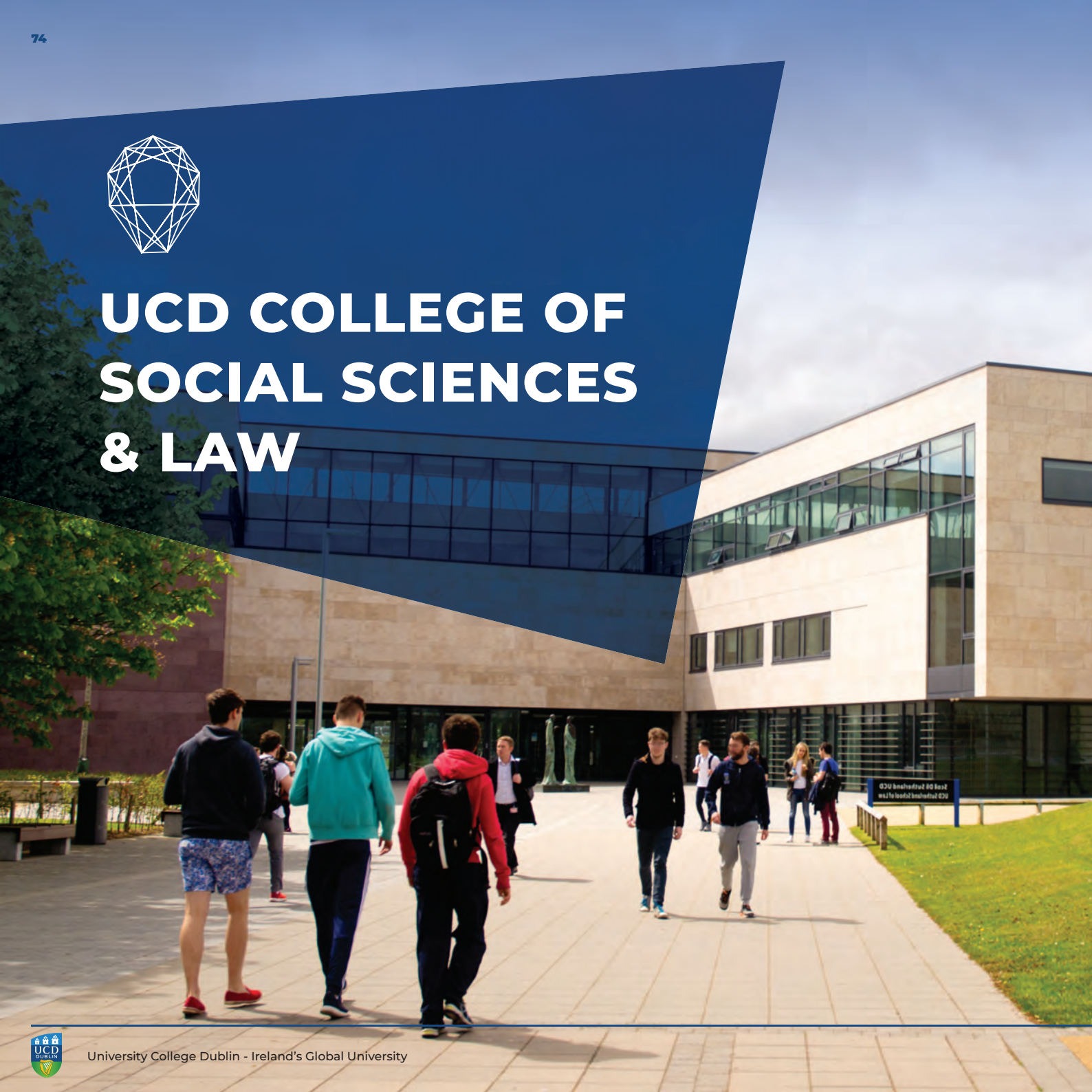

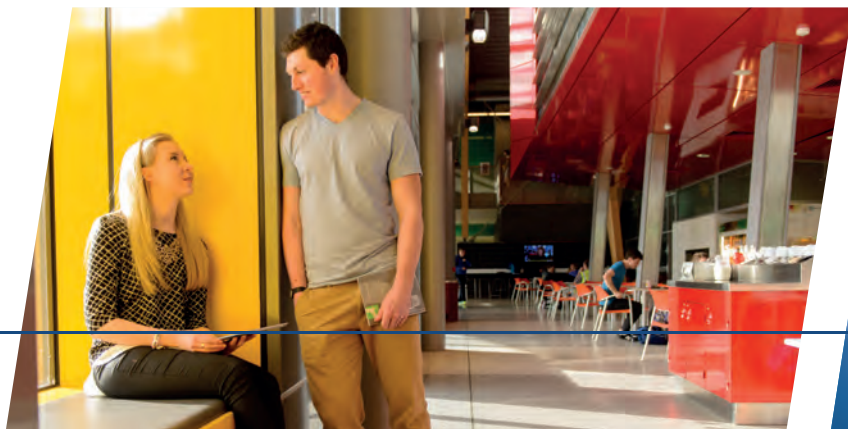
